



- Target students: P4 (26 diverse learners)
- Module: Food and drinks
- Unit: Eating habits
- Task: Healthy diet the health detectives
- Language focus: Speaking

BACKGROUND

Previous knowledge:

- The students have learnt relevant vocabulary about healthy and unhealthy diets.
- They have learnt health problems (e.g. overweight, underweight & diabetes, etc).
- They have learnt to give advice by using the modal 'should'.

Learning objectives:


By the end of the lesson, the students should be able to:










CASE 3: PEPPA


• Name: Peppa

Age: 10 years old


- Health report:
